What is The Victoria Health Co-operative?

The Victoria Health Co-operative (VictoriaHealthCooperative.com) is a formal incorporation of legal persons (individuals and other legal entities), passionate about well-being for ourselves and our community. Members benefit from access to a carefully selected group of wellness practitioners from many disciplines and to a range of wellness and health-related services.

The Victoria Health Co-operative is introducing a new 'Nurse Practitioner Project' to provide Primary Health Care at three host locations in Victoria.

Creating Community Wellness Society (CWSS; The 'Wellness Charity' WellnessCharity.ca) supports the Victoria Health Co-operative and similar initiatives. The CWSS is a designated charitable organization (CRA 83383 5457 RR 0001). Donations to the Wellness Charity are eligible for Charitable Donation tax receipts.

Why Are We Raising Money?

The Victoria Health Cooperative, through the Creating Community Wellness Society is raising funds to support a nurse practitioner, medical office assistant and 4 treatment room locations in Victoria

The NP will:

- Have a patient list of up to 800 Victoria residents
- Be based in treatment spaces in Cook Street Activity Centre, Centennial United Church, Our Place and potentially a location in James Bay
- Require a Medical Office Assistant (MoA)

To secure stable, long-term funding for these positions, the Victoria Health Cooperative is looking to raise:

- \$250,000 per year (to cover salaries, benefits, MERCs and consumable office/medical supplies), and
- \$60,000 one-time costs to outfit 4 treatment rooms
